Individuals with CNS pathophysiology have dysfunction in posture and movement and subsequent functional activity limitations. The Bobaths developed the NDT/Bobath approach to address these problems. The NDT/Bobath approach continues to be enriched with the emergence of new theories, new models and new information in the movement sciences. In addition, as the characteristics of the population with CNS pathophysiology change, the approach continues to evolve. The reputation and effectiveness of this approach to the therapy care of children and adults has been well-established, respected and recognized for decades.
